Exhibitors may only enter one arrangement in each class. In all arrangements, no artificial flowers or plants may be used. Fresh and dried materials cannot be treated or dyed, but must remain natural.

NOTE that the Apple Award will be given in any class which allows the use of apples in the arrangement

SECTION I PRESSED FLOWER ART

Class 1. Eternal Division I: Live pressed flowers and greenery only. Division II: Live pressed flowers and greenery, accompanied by self-drawn artwork.

SECTION II DESIGNER'S CHOICE

Class 2. Field of Dreams

Dried and/or fresh materials may be used, and accessories in keeping with the theme are allowed. These may include the container or elements added to the arrangement to reflect the theme.

SECTION III DOOR DECORATIONS

Class 3. Doorway to Virginia

Door decorations including wreaths and swags using fresh and/or dried materials. ABSOLUTELY NO ARTIFICIAL FLOWERS, GREENERY, WREATHS, ETC WILL BE

ALLOWED. Grapevine, straw, Styrofoam, or wire forms allowed. Use of ribbon and/or bows allowed. Wreath stands will be provided.

SECTION IV CHILDREN'S EXHIBITS

Class 4. From My Own Backyard

Children may use fresh flowers to create an arrangement celebrating items found in their own backyards. Arrangements should be no larger than 12" x 12". Accessories are permitted and the use of apples in the arrangement is encouraged.
